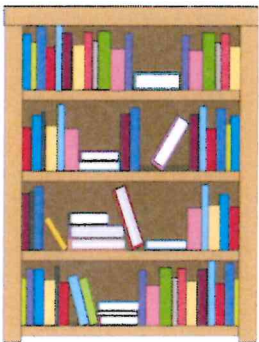
### “Race to 100” Campaign!
