Invest in Kids – Help Needed!

Since January, Empower Illinois has been working hard to re-instate the Invest in Kids Act. This has included meeting with legislators, listening to their concerns, asking the lobbyists to meet with specific legislators, working with the lead sponsors, and trying to build partnerships with school choice minded coalitions.

However, progress is slow moving. The majority of the legislators want this to go away. Thanks to the Invest in Kids Act, we have had over 50 scholarships, for tuition and fees, awarded to our students. That is over \$300,000.00. Empower Illinois needs help in getting the Invest in Kids Act re-instated. They need people to come to Springfield to meet with their legislators. If you can't go to Springfield, call and email your legislators, and keep calling and emailing them. This program provides the opportunity for students to receive a Catholic/private education that they may not be able to afford otherwise. This program also allows donors to pick where some of their tax dollars go (such as to SAS in the way of scholarships), plus, getting a tax credit for the donation.

Please contact or meet with your legislators, tell them you want the program re-instated.
